

ORDINANCE NO. 02-05

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CORUNNA, MICHIGAN, CHAPTER 2 – ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE IV. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, DIVISION 2. PLANNING COMMISSION, BY AMENDING SECTION 2-157. MEMBERSHIP THEREOF.

THE CITY OF CORUNNA, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT TO SECTIONS 2-157 (MEMBERSHIP) AND 2-158 (REMOVAL OF MEMBERS), OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF CORUNNA, MICHIGAN, shall be as follows:

Sec. 2-157. Membership.

(a)—The city planning commission heretofore established is continued, shall consist of seven members who shall represent insofar as possible different professions or occupations. Six of the members shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to approval of the city council by majority vote. One member shall be a member of the city council selected by resolution of the city council to serve as a member ex officio with full voting rights. The term of the ex officio member shall be determined by the city council, but the term shall not exceed the member's term of office as a member of the city council. The term of each appointed member shall be three years or until his or her successor takes office, EXCEPT that the respective terms of two of the members first appointed shall be for one year and two for two years. Each member shall hold office until his successor has been appointed; and, vacancies occurring other than through term expiration, shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term as herein above provided.

- (1) The commission shall consist of seven (7) administrative officers appointed in accordance with section 4.7 (administrative service) of the City Charter for indefinite terms serving at the pleasure of the Council. The members shall represent insofar as possible different professions or occupations.
- (2) Of the commission membership there will be a president and vice-president, voted upon by the entire commission. The City Manager shall provide for a secretary to record the meetings. All meetings must have four (4) members present to enact business.
- (3) ~~(b) All members of the planning commission, including the city council member serving ex officio, shall serve as such without compensation.~~ The seven-person commission membership shall not include a City Councilperson or the Mayor. The entire membership shall be comprised of residents of the City of Corunna. ~~An appointed member shall not hold another municipal office except as provided herein, and also except one appointed member may be a member of the zoning board of appeals.~~
- (4) Proposed minutes of the Planning Commission meetings are to be submitted to the City Manager within ten (10) business days following the Planning Commission meeting. Approved minutes are to be submitted to the City Manager within five (5) days of approval.
- (5) Any commissioner absent two (2) consecutive meetings or twenty-five percent (25%) of regular meetings in a calendar year, without prior written approval by the City Manager, will be considered for removal from the commission. All absences shall be recorded in the meeting minutes.
- (6) Upon recommendation of the City Manager, the city council may appoint one (1) ex officio member to the commission. The ex officio members so appointed by the city council shall not have a vote at the meetings, but shall sit only in an advisory capacity.
- (7) All Administrative officers shall be responsible to the City Manager in and for the performance of the duties of their office.

Sec. 2-158. Removal of Members.

~~After a public hearing, a member other than the member selected by the city council may be removed by the mayor for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office. The office of any member who shall be absent from three consecutive meetings of the commission, unless such absences are excused at the time they occur, or at or prior to the third such absence, shall automatically become vacant. The city council may, for like cause, remove the member selected by the city council.~~

SECTION 2. Severability.

This Ordinance and the several sections, sub-sections, paragraphs, clauses and parts thereof are hereby declared to be severable. If any part or clause thereof is declared or adjudged invalid by present or future legislation or decree, the balance of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 3. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed.

All Ordinances previously adopted and incorporated in the Code of the City of Corunna, Michigan, through codification procedures, or any existing Ordinances that are inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, and in the case of inconsistencies, to the extent of such inconsistency, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Copies Available.

This Ordinance may be purchased or inspected in the City Clerk's Offices, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

SECTION 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect pursuant to the Corunna City Charter, immediately upon publication hereof.
